

BACKGROUND REPORT

The Golden Tap Award is presented by the Utilities Commission to recognize exceptional service and dedication to excellence in Utility service to the citizens of Stafford County. The winner of the first Golden Tap Award (1999) was Mr. Alvin Bandy.

This year's winner is Mr. Larry Chronister. Mr. Chronister is employed by Parsons Engineering. He always looks out for the County's best interest on all projects on which he has worked. He uses his extensive knowledge of construction management to ensure that the County consistently receives a quality product. Mr. Chronister's first project for the County, in 1996, was construction manager at the award winning Smith Lake Dam.

Subsequently, Mr. Chronister served the County nearly continuously in a succession of high-value infrastructure construction projects, including the most significant upgrades at the County's four water and sewer treatment facilities during the past fifteen years. He labored side-by-side with up-and-coming current and former Utilities Department leaders.

Currently, Mr. Chronister continues to serve the County's Utilities Department tasked with managing construction projects during the ongoing development of the Rocky Pen run Reservoir and water treatment plant.
