## **BACKGROUND REPORT**

An application was submitted for an outdoor entertainment permit to conduct a beach fest/fundraising event at 83 Woodrow Drive, Tax Map Parcel 41B-1-19, pursuant to Stafford County Code Section 4-36 *et seq*. The promoter, John Zorich, is planning to host a one-day event known as Widewater Beach Fest to raise money for the organization Final Salute, Inc. This organization was established in 2010 to assist homeless female veterans by providing shelter and/or rent, child care assistance, employment support, and other essential services. The event is scheduled for Saturday, August 2, 2014 from 2:00 pm to 10:00 pm. and will include live performances from several bands, and a raffle drawing for a pontoon boat. Food will be available for purchase from several food trucks, and alcoholic beverages will be permitted but not sold.

As required by County Code, the applicant submitted plans for providing sanitary facilities, trash disposal, emergency medical treatment, and fire protection for the event. The appropriate County departments will review and approve these plans, and work with the applicant to ensure compliance with the County Code and state regulations. In addition, all permits required by the Virginia Department of Health, the Virginia Department of Alcohol Beverage Control, and the County will be approved prior to the event.

Staff reviewed the application and recommends approval of proposed Resolution R14-165, which approves Widewater Beach Fest, subject to final approval of all applicable County and State permits.

SUBJECT: Widewater Beachfest '14 Outdoor Musical Festival Permit

TO: Stafford County Zoning Board

Charity Event: For 9 years, our Widewater Beach neighborhood has supported and hosted an annual "charity" event on my personal property at 80/83 Woodrow Drive. We call it Widewater Beachfest. In our early years, we raised money for the Wounded Warrior Project and for the last 3 years, Final Salute, Inc. Final Salute helps the 55,000 homeless women Veterans in the United States find safe and suitable housing. Homeless women Veterans are the fastest growing population of homelessness in the United States.

**Family Oriented:** Widewater Beachfest is a family oriented, pet friendly, charity event. It is a semi private event where our family and friends spread the word to their family and friends. It is unusual, even unheard of, that we, or our family and friends, don't know every one of the 500 people in attendance. As a boating community, our friends extend to the shores of the Potomac, Aquia Creek, and Fairview Beach. Many of these friends attend and support our event.

Musical Performances: Widewater Beachfest is an old fashion family picnic and beach festival rolled into one, where we also feature local musicians. The musical entertainment includes local musicians that play in and around the Stafford and surrounding areas, such as Willem, Pete Baker, the Anthony James band, Jenna Curry, and more. We have featured kids as young as 8 and 9 years old, including a neighbor who has performed at each event for the last 9 years and she is only 16 years old, Jenna Curry. Her band called the Diamond Dolls, ages 13-16, will be performing this year. Widewater Beachfest has provided a venue for young artists that may even become stars someday! This year we are featuring a band called "Bruce in the USA" the world's greatest tribute band to Bruce Springsteen. They have played locally in Falls Church at the State Theatre among other venues in the DELMARVA area.

Games, Grills & Good Food: We have family games such as volleyball, horseshoes, corn hole, badminton, bocce ball, and more. Families are welcomed to bring their own coolers and picnic baskets. We provide grills for cooking, lots of ice, and we even have some local, food vendors. This year we will have a food truck from Pick-a-Part, Fun Time Ice Cream owned by Clifford Dent, and Smooth's BBQ which attends many festivals and music events in and around Stafford. They are officially licensed businesses with appropriate permits to operate in Stafford County.

**Safety & Security:** This is our 10<sup>th</sup> year hosting the event and we have never had an incident requiring the police. We have, and will continue to take, all necessary precautions to assure a safe, fun event for families. To that end, we establish a DUI checkpoint to assure no one leaves under the influence. We make announcements throughout the day and coordinate with the Stafford County Sheriff's department to make their presence known at our entrance. We encourage many to pitch their tent in an area we call Tent City. We have a large security presence with the appropriate

yellow "EVENT STAFF" shirts. We take this event serious, while having a great time raising money for a worthwhile cause.

**\$40,000 Goal:** At this year's event, we have a raffle for a new Pontoon Boat. Holly Acres in Woodbridge, VA has been a huge supporter in past years and has worked to secure a new boat at a greatly reduced cost to us. Tickets are only \$20 and we are limiting sales to 2,000 tickets. We conduct a raffle for large flat screen HDTVs and stereo systems donated by various businesses and corporations. We sell commemorative T-Shirts too. Our overall goal for this year's event is to raise \$40,000 for Final Salute, Inc.

The following information is being submitted in accordance with County Code, Chapter 4, Amusements, Article II Outdoor Musical or Entertainment Festivals, Division 2 Permit. The paragraphs indicate the Section from the code to which the information is related.

- **(4-24) Festival Information:** Widewater Beachfest '14 is scheduled from 2pm to 10pm on Saturday, August 2, 2014. We expect approximately 500 attendees. The venue is 200 x 150 feet of open space on the waterfront property at 83 Woodrow Drive in Stafford, Virginia. There are no enclosed structures for the event.
- **(4-25) Length of Performances:** The music for Widewater Beachfest '14 will start at 2:30pm and will end at 10:00pm.
- **(4-26) Admission of minors:** This is a family oriented, pet friendly event. No minors under the age of 18 are allowed unless accompanied by a parent or guardian. We also ID all persons attending the event. If they are under the age of 21, they will receive a different color wrist band indicating their "under 21" status.
- **(4-36) Permit Required:** This is an application for a formal festival permit. This application includes a full description of the plans, statements, approvals, and other items submitted at the time of the festival permit and subsequently received. All documentation will be retained on site for review.

## (4-38) Statements, plans, etc., to accompany application

(1) Tickets: There are no official tickets to the event. This is a charity event and festivalgoers are asked to make a donation to Final Salute, Inc. A \$20 donation is recommended but not mandatory. A wristband will be placed on all attendees that donate any amount to our charity. Children under the age of 18 are included with their parent's donation, if they so choose to make a donation. We expect approximately 500-600 attendees. The breakdown includes 150-200 neighbors and their family and friends; 150-200 Boaters will be attending via boat (approximately 50 Boats). The remaining 200 attendees will drive to the event. An event poster is included.

**(2) Promoters:** John P. Zorich (80 Woodrow Drive, Stafford, VA) is the promoter of the event and has been for the 9 previous years. Jaspen Boothe, Founder/President of Final Salute, Inc., is the sponsor and Final Salute is financially backing the event. Final Salute is also carrying the insurance for the event. The performers scheduled to play are:

2:30 – 3:30: Pete Baker 3:30 – 4:30: Jenna Curry

4:30 – 5:30: The Diamond Dolls (Calista Garcia, Eliza Stuart, Jenna Curry, Lilly Leibel)

5:30 – 7:00: The Anthony James Band (Anthony Gerogosian, Steve Ontiveros, Joe Kelly, Marc Guillaume)

7:00 – 7:30: Jenna & Willem (Jenna Curry, Willem Dicke)

7:30 – 10:00: Bruce in the USA (Matt Ryan, Matthew Sully, Dave McLaurin, Joey Lunsford, Atticus Finch, Danny Miranda, Jay Nichols)

- **(3) Event Location:** Widewater Beachfest takes place at 80/83 Woodrow Drive on the private property of Mr. John P. Zorich. Mr. Zorich is a Member of the Board of Directors for Final Salute, Inc., a 501c3 charity that helps the 55,000 homeless women Veterans find safe and suitable housing.
- (4) Sanitation Facilities, Garbage, Trash and Sewage: We plan to have 6 portable toilets (1 per 100 people) for the event, including one ADA/Wheel chair accessible unit. In addition, nearly every one of the 50 boats attending has a bathroom. And the neighbors (and their friends and family) use their own facilities in their homes. We will have over 20 trash bins stationed throughout the grounds to include a dozen recyclable bins. A local Girl Scout Troop, 2267, has volunteered to manage all trash and recyclables during the event. A trailer is used to hold the trash before it is hauled off to the Stafford County dump on Monday. A second clean up crew has been identified and polices the entire neighborhood early on Sunday morning.
- (5) Plan for providing food, water, and lodging: This is a festival and attendees bring their own coolers, complete with food and drink. BBQ grills are provided so they can cook their food. However, there are 3 planned food vendors for the event. Smooth's BBQ (permitted), Fun Times Ice Cream (permitted), and Sandra's Food Truck from Pick a Part (permitted). No lodging is being provided, however, guests are encouraged to pitch a personal tent overnight if they are under the influence. We do have an agreement with Global Cab Company to assist people that may need a hotel room for the night. A reduced fare has been negotiated and we have secured reduced hotel room rates with a number of hotels in Stafford near Route 610.
- **(6) First Aid:** A first aid station complete with water, bandages, cream for burns, suntan lotion, and other emergency items will be available at the main entrance. We have a number of neighbors and friends attending that are Fairfax

County and Stafford County Firemen and they have volunteered to assist in the case of an emergency.

- (7) Parking: All parking will be provided on private lots on Woodrow Drive. We have secured agreements with many neighbors and they have volunteered their property for parking in order to assure all streets are free and clear. The homeowners at 76, 80, 82, 87, 92, 111, and 120 Woodrow Drive have agreed to allow parking on their lawns. "No street parking" signs will be placed on Woodrow Drive, Shore Drive, Mynel Street, and George Street. The total available acreage for parking is approximately 5 acres and can accommodate well over 100 cars. We expect fewer than 60 cars. Due to the length of the event, and with a limited number of cars driving to the event, the need for any additional traffic controls is unnecessary as adequate county road signs currently exist. With the arrival and departure times naturally staggered, we do not expect any traffic problems.
- **(8) Fire Plan:** Mr. Scott Smith, Fairfax County Fireman and member of the elite Fairfax County Rescue Team, is developing a Fire Plan for Beachfest. The two areas of concern are the docked boats and the BBQ area. We will have plenty of water available and all boats have the required safety equipment including fire extinguishers. The BBQ area will also have at least 2 fire extinguishers and 2 water hoses from the neighboring homes. This plan is attached.
- **(9) Outdoor Lights:** The property currently has lights over the volleyball court, providing adequate coverage for the event. The two lights are 1,500 watts halogen light fixtures. The angle of the lights point down onto the volleyball court preventing any unreasonable glows beyond the property. The stage will use LED lights specific to the stage for the entertainers, also preventing any unreasonable glows beyond the property.
- **(10) Sound:** All music played through the sound equipment/speakers will not violate any provision of Chapter 16 of the Country Code and will comply with all Noise permit requirements.
- **(4-40) Permission to Enter Property:** All Stafford County official board members, its lawful agents and duly constituted law enforcement officers may go upon the property (80/83 Woodrow Drive, Stafford, VA, 22554) at any time for the purpose of determining compliance with the provisions of this article.

**Permits Required:** Many permits are required and the applications are being submitted at this time to the appropriate officials. All permits will be available and on file upon issuance. The following list summarizes the permits we are requesting:

- **a. Noise Permit** Required. Will have on file. Completed permit will be available for review.
- **b. ABC Permit** Required. Will have on file. Festivalgoers may bring their own coolers with adult beverages; however, we don't provide or sell any alcohol. All

festivalgoers must provide an ID and those 21 and over will have a specific wristband indicating they are 21 and over.

- **c.** Festival Permit Required. Submitted. Certificate of Insurance will be provided as soon as it is available from Final Salute's Attorney and Insurance Company.
- **d. Tent Permit** Not required. The only tent we are providing will cover the stage if there is inclement weather. Our musical stage is 16x28 or 448 square feet. A tent permit is only required if it is 900 square feet. Festivalgoers may bring their own tents for sleeping. We do not provide these tents but we encourage people to bring their own tents rather than drive under ANY influence. We make over a dozen announcements about driving under the influence, we establish a DUI checkpoint, and we ask the Stafford County Sheriff to make their presence known.
- **e. Stage Permit** Not required. I have a putting green/deck on my property. It is level but on a slightly sloped grade where I have elevated one corner of it about a foot off the ground. It sits on the ground. A stage permit is only required where one is constructed specifically for the event. This is not the case for Widewater Beachfest.
- **f. Environmental Waste Plan** We have a local Girl Scout Troop, 2267, that will be handling all of our sanitation/waste needs. We will recycle all cans and bottles. We have a trash trailer where all bags are place prior to taking to the county dump on Monday. We also have a Sunday morning clean up crew established to police the neighborhood. I have also provided my personal phone number to every neighbor in case there is trash in his or her yards.
- **g. Generator Permit** Required. Will be on file. The generator will be used to provide power for docked boats. This will help to run their Air Conditioners, as the temperature is normally quite warm in early August.
- **j. Security Plan** Required. Will be on file. The security plan is being developed. It identifies how we operate and the visibility of our security team, as well as our coordination with the Stafford Country Sheriff's office. We also have signs and warnings at our entrance, where we list the items attendees cannot bring into the event, including fireworks and weapons.
- **k. Bouncy House/Amusement Permit** Required. Will be on file. The "Bouncy House" is a small waterfall type unit purchased at Walmart. It will be in the kiddie area for parents with young children. Serial number and information to be provided.

# WIDEWATER BEACHFEST '14 EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN (EAP)

(Weather, Fire, Medical, Law, Parking, Emergency Vehicles, Contact Information & Site Plan)

## I. GENERAL

The "Widewater Beachfest 2014" will be held August 2, 2014 at 80 & 83 Woodrow Drive, Stafford VA 22554, from 2-10pm.

## II. PURPOSE

- A. This emergency action plan predetermines actions to take before and during the "Widewater Beachfest 2014" (hereinafter referred to as the event) in response to an emergency or otherwise hazardous condition. These actions will be taken by organizers, management, personnel, and attendees. These actions represent those required prior to the event in preparation for and those required during an emergency.
- B. Flexibility must be exercised when implementing this plan because of the wide variety of potential hazards that exist for this event. These hazards include, but are not limited to, Fire, Medical Emergencies, Severe Weather, or situations where Law Enforcement is required.

## III. ASSUMPTIONS

The possibility of an occurrence of an emergency is present at this event. The types of emergencies possible are various and could require the response of Fire & Rescue, Emergency Medical Services, and Police.

## IV. BASIC PLAN

## A. EAP Event Representative

1. The EAP event representative will be identified as the point of contact for all communications regarding the event. This person is identified as Mr. John P. Zorich. The alternative EAP event representative is Ms. Monica Zorich.

## B. Emergency Notification

1. In the event of an emergency, notification of the emergency will be through the use of 911. The caller

- should have the following information available to the 911 operator: nature of emergency, location, and contact person with callback number.
- 2. While we will not have an official EMS person on site, we will have off duty EMS personnel and fireman on site to help facilitate any emergency; however, all calls will be through the host POC, Mr. John P. Zorich, 703.989.7784. The secondary phone number to use is for Monica Zorich, 540.446.1480.

## C. Severe Weather

- Weather forecasts and current conditions will be monitored through the National Weather Service's Sterling Weather Forecast Office web site at <a href="https://www.weather.gov/">www.weather.gov/</a>.
- Before the event If severe weather is predicted prior to the event, the EAP event representative will evaluate the conditions and determine if the event will remain scheduled. The EAP event representative or his/her designee will be identified as such and will be responsible to monitor the weather conditions before and during the event.
- During the event If severe weather occurs during the event, the EAP event representative or his/her designee will make notification to those attending the event that a hazardous weather condition exists and direct them to shelter.
- 4. There are very limited provisions for sheltering participants in the event of severe weather; although there are plenty of neighbors willing to open their homes in such an event.

  Announcements will be made from the stage.
- 5. This event will follow the 30-30 Rule for lightning. If lightning is observed and thunder is heard within 30 seconds, the event will be delayed until 30 minutes have past since thunder was last heard.

## Tornado:

- When a warning is issued by sirens or other means, seek inside shelter. Consider the following:
  - a. Small interior rooms on the lowest floor and without windows,
  - b. Hallways on the lowest floor away from doors and windows, and
  - c. Rooms constructed with reinforced concrete, brick, or block with no windows.

- 2. Stay away from outside walls and windows.
- 3. Use arms to protect head and neck.
- 4. Remain sheltered until the tornado threat is announced to be over.

## Earthquake:

- Stay calm and await instructions from the Emergency Coordinator or the designated official.
- 2. Keep away from overhead fixtures, windows, filing cabinets, and electrical power.
- 3. Assist people with disabilities in finding a safe place.
- 4. Evacuate as instructed by the Emergency Coordinator and/or the designated official.

## Hurricane:

The nature of a hurricane provides for more warning than other natural and weather disasters. A hurricane watch issued when a hurricane becomes a threat to a coastal area. A hurricane warning is issued when hurricane winds of 74 mph or higher, or a combination of dangerously high water and rough seas, are expected in the area within 24 hours.

- 1. Once a hurricane watch has been issued:
  - a) Stay calm and await instructions from the Emergency Coordinator or the designated official.
  - b) Moor any boats securely, or move to a safe place if time allows.
  - c) Continue to monitor local TV and radio stations for instructions.
  - Move early out of low-lying areas or from the coast, at the request of officials.
  - e) If you are on high ground, away from the coast and plan to stay, secure the building, moving all loose items indoors and boarding up windows and openings.
  - f)Collect drinking water in appropriate containers.
- Once a hurricane warning has been issued:
  - a) Be ready to evacuate as directed by the Emergency Coordinator and/or the designated official.
  - b) Leave areas that might be affected by storm tide or stream flooding.
- 3. During a hurricane:
  - a) Remain indoors and consider the following:
  - b) Small interior rooms on the lowest floor and without windows,
  - c) Hallways on the lowest floor away from doors

and windows, and

 Rooms constructed with reinforced concrete, brick, or block with no windows.

## D. Fire

- 1. No specific hazard has been identified as an increased risk of fire at this event except for the BBQ grills.
- 2. All event staff will be instructed on the safe use of Portable Fire Extinguishers.
- 3. The use of open flame for grilling is permitted under the Fire Code when the following conditions are met:
  - a) Must have a valid fire extinguisher, 2A10BC or class
     K.
  - Each space is allowed 1 LP tank per cooking device and only 1 spare LP tank regardless of the number of cooking devices. All LP tanks are to be secured in an approved manner (tied, strapped, chained, etc.)
  - c) All tents/canopies used for cooking shall have a FLAME SPREAD Certification attached to the tent.
- 4. Should an incident occur that requires the Fire Department, 911 will be utilized to request this resource.
  - a) The caller should have the following information available to the 911 operator: nature of emergency, location, and contact person with callback number
- 5. Fight the fire ONLY if:
  - a) The Fire Department has been notified.
  - b) The fire is small and is not spreading to other areas.
  - c) Escaping the area is possible by backing up to the nearest exit.
  - d) The fire extinguisher is in working condition and personnel are trained to use it.
- 6. Upon being notified about the fire emergency, occupants must:
  - a) Leave the area using the designated escape routes.
  - Remain outside the emergency area until the competent authority (Designated Official or designee) announces that it is safe to reenter.
- 7. Designated Official, Emergency Coordinator or supervisors must:
  - a) Coordinate an orderly evacuation of personnel.
  - b) Provide the Fire Department personnel with the necessary information about the facility and the emergency.
- 8. Area Monitors must:
  - a) Ensure that all people have evacuated the area.
  - b) Report any problems to the Emergency Coordinator

at the assembly area.
Assistants to Physically Challenged should:

a) Assist all physically challenged people in emergency evacuation.

## E. Medical Emergencies

- As with any outdoor event, there is potential for injury to the participants. The types of injuries are various and include those that are heat related as well as traumatic injuries.
- 2. There are minimal provisions for on-site Emergency Medical Services at this event. A first aid kit will be maintained at the main entrance.

Should an incident occur that requires Emergency Medical Services, contact Mr. John Zorich, 703.989.7784, to request and coordinate the necessary emergency resources. The caller will have the following information available: EMS POC, nature of emergency, precise location, and contact person with callback number.

## F. Law Enforcement

- The need for constant Law Enforcement presence at this event has been identified and coordinated with Stafford County Sheriff. The county, as in years past, will keep a visible presence near the front entrance on Woodrow Drive.
- Should an incident occur that requires Law Enforcement, John P. Zorich will request this resource. The caller will have the following information available: the nature of emergency, precise location, and contact person with callback number.

## G. Emergency Vehicle Access


- Access for Emergency Vehicles will be maintained at all times.
- 2. Fire lanes and fire hydrants will not be obstructed. Participants and spectators will be directed to park in approved areas and not to obstruct protective features, sidewalks or public throughways. Parking on roads in Widewater Beach will NOT be allowed. Appropriate signage will be noted. Designate parking areas will be used

- for all attendees, vendor and staff vehicles. Parking will be on Woodrow Drive, at the following addresses: at 76, 80, 82, 87, 92, 111, and 120.
- 3. Crowd control will be managed by private security hired for this event. Accolade Security Networks, Patrol & Security, 56 Joseph Mills Road, Fredericksburg, Virginia 22408.






